# *Welcome to the Summer Olympics!*

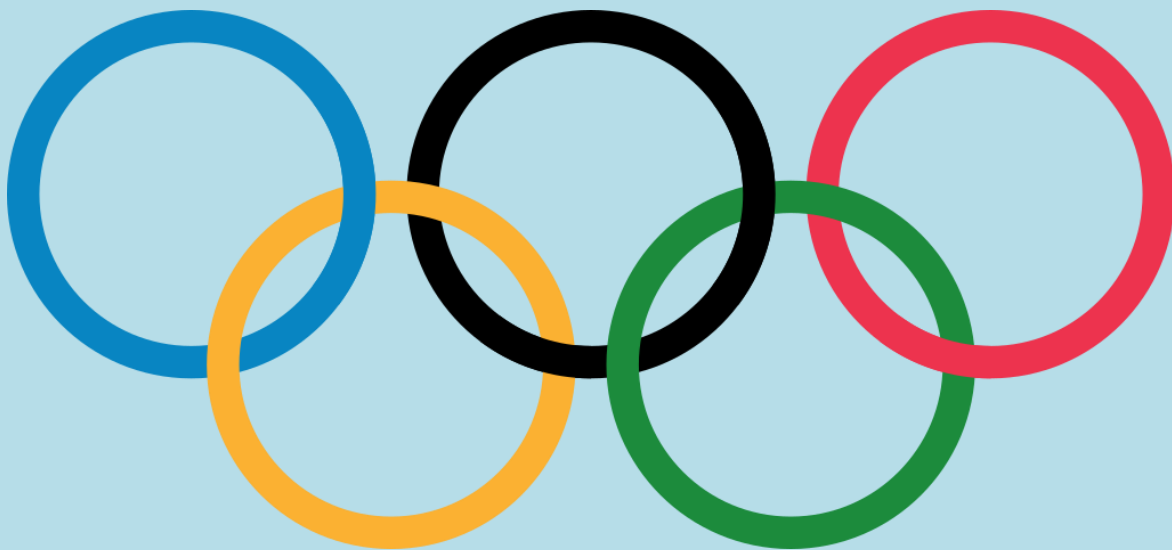
